

WREATHS OF VALOUR AND CHIVALRY

Ceremony for the presentation of the Wreaths of Valour and Chivalry

PREPARATION: The Herald should obtain the names of the victors from Their Majesties before Court.

Scroll/Promissory: None

Token: Wreaths of Rosemary, one with a red ribbon (for the Wreath of Valour), the other with white (for the Wreath of Chivalry).

NOTE: DO NOT CALL RECIPIENTS YET!



Herald:

All combatants in the Crown Tournament today fought with bravery, courtesy and honor. However, there are always some who stand out above the rest in chivalry and in valour. Let (name) and (name) , come now before Their Majesties.

(Those named come forward and kneel before Their Majesties. The one named who is to receive the Wreath of Valour should be directed to kneel before His Majesty, while the one named who is to receive the Wreath of Chivalry should kneel before Her Majesty.)



King:

You fought with outstanding valour and courage on the field this day. (His Majesty may add what other words He feels important here.) Therefore, it is Our pleasure to reward you with the Wreath of Valour.



King:

(The King places the Wreath of Valour on the head of the recipient.)



Queen:

You fought with outstanding chivalry and honor on the field this day. (Her Majesty may add what over words She feels important here.) Therefore, it is Our pleasure to reward you with the Wreath of Chivalry.



Queen:

(The Queen places the Wreath of Chivalry on the head of the recipient.)



Herald:

For (name) and (name) recipients of the Wreaths of Valour and Chivalry, Hip, Hip! (*3)



King/Queen: You have Our leave to depart.
