The Lochac Order of Grace

<u>Awarded for:</u> once per reign, given by the Queen to the person she considers to have displayed exceptional courtesy.

<u>Token:</u> a favour, most often a pouch, depicting the badge of the order, being *gules*, a hind courant Or between three mullets of six points argent.

Prep: The Crown should know who made the token to be given (traditionally the previous recipient), and should be prepared to speak of the recipient's deeds. The Herald must determine how many Queens of Lochac there have been to this time. In the 24th year of the Society, Rowena, fourth Princess of Lochac, saw that Jessica of Fearn Abbey displayed such courtesy and grace that she was an inspiration to all, the Princess no less than any, and so the Lochac Order of Grace was created. Each Lady to rule Lochac proudly maintained her right to recognise once in her reign the greatest exemplar of courtesy in her lands, and when Lochac became a Kingdom, our Queens would not think to surrender this right. Be assured that the members of the Lochac Order of Grace truly shine before all the Kingdoms of the Known World.

The recipients of this high honour are given a token of the Crown's favour, bearing the badge of the order, being gules, a hind courant

On this [day] of [month] Anno Societatis [year], her Majesty [Name], the [numbered] Queen of Lochac, claims this privilege, and with [Name], King of Lochac, wishes to

We also grant you with this an award of arms, with the rights and titles of a lord/lady of the realm, and charge you with the responsibilities of this rank, and we further give you the right to bear as personal arms such device as you may have properly registered with our heralds, in the Kingdom of Lochac and throughout the Known World.

Herald:

For Lord/Lady [*Name*], the newest member of the Lochac Order of Grace – three cheers!
