The submitter provides photocopies showing "-win" on p499 ibid..

Δt: is documented as the usual OE preposition for indicating residence.


Eoforeslea: The "e" should have a line over it but I can't do that at the moment. (É, É, É, é, è or é? Him can't, me can! Æ.S.)

This name is constructed as per OE naming practise from "Eofor-" (boar) (genitive -es) and "Leah" (wood) (dative Lea). Hence Eofoeslea meaning Boar's Forest. Photocopies are provided from Ekwall(p278, 160, 162) showing the elements.
