Order of the Miles Regni

<u>Awarded for:</u> supporting the army of Lochac in any significant manner, including siege weapons and non-contact participants such as marshals, banner bearers, etc.

Token: a silver sword, worn as a pendant.

<u>Prep:</u> the **Crown** should be prepared to speak of the recipient's deeds, *especially* if their service is as a non-combatant. The **Herald** should check if the recipient holds an AoA already; <u>if not</u>, they receive one as part of the ceremony.

<u>Armigerous:</u> Yes, AoA. <u>Scroll:</u> No <u>Crown litany:</u> No

If the Crown wishes to call the recipient up before the ceremony starts, ignore "Let [Name] come before their Majesties"

Herald: Though Lochac is a peaceful Kingdom, it happens that at times the drums of war are sounded, and the Crown must call on the combatants of the Kingdom to do their duty. The armies of Lochac are great and varied, with many skills, both martial and supportive. The Crown would recognise those who through their labours strengthen the Armies of Lochac and thus the Kingdom itself. It is for this reason that the Miles Regni was created, to recognise those who give their best in the defence of Lochac, whatever their area of expertise.

Let [Name] come before their Majesties.

Recipient comes before their Majesties and kneels.

Crown: Speak of the recipient's deeds and bestow the token of the order.

- Herald We also give you the rights and titles of a lord/lady of the realm, and charge you with the responsibilities of this rank, and we further give you the right to bear as arms such device as you may have properly registered with our heralds, in the Kingdom of Lochac and throughout the Known World.
- Herald: Know all that their Majesties, King [Name] and Queen [Name] have this [day] of [month] Anno Societatis [year] made Lord/Lady [Name] the newest member of the Miles Regni – three cheers!
