- * **Eduard Andrien.** Name and device. Azure, two chevronels Or semy-de-lis sable, in chief two rabbits salient respectant argent.
- * **Elef á Suðrmannalandi.** Name and Device. Argent, three moths one and two purpure, a chief vert semy of wood sorrel blossoms argent.
- * **Elwald Knudson.** Name and device. Argent, a labyrinth azure and a bordure azure lozengy argent.
- * **Jóra Styrmisdóttir.** Name.
- * **Natal'ia Anastasiia Rab'eva.** Device. Per bend sinister Or and purpure, a set of nesting scale weights and a drawn bow with an arrow nocked counterchanged.

- * **Róisin Cinnsealach.** Name and Device. Vert, a sprig of oak leaves and on a bordure argent an orle sable.
