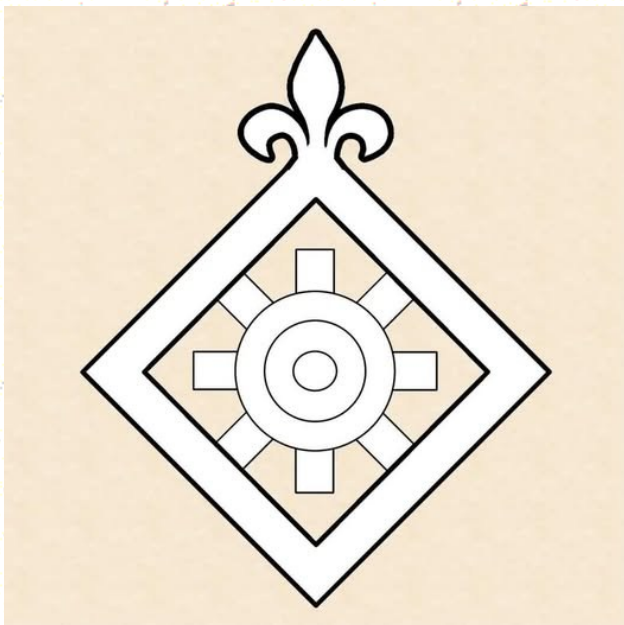


I look forward to working with them.

Ranged martial pursuits include target archery, combat archery, siege weaponry, and thrown weapons. Members are addressed as "Master" (name) or "Mistress" (name). The regalia of the Order is two white vambraces or bracers, and the badge: "(tinctureless) A set of nesting scale weights within and conjoined to a mascle fleury at the upper point." Elevations" to this newest Peerage begin on June 7, 2025.
