CRUX AUSTRALIS HERALD

Next week at Rowany Festival, I will be retiring as Crux Australis Herald. The new Crux Australis will be Baron Gereint Scholar. All business from April should be sent to him. I will be taking up the new position of Hund Pursuivant.

HUND MEETINGS

Hund (Commenting) Meetings are on every Monday at 8pm. These have been very peripatetic lately so **check with me before embarking**. I cannot predict the venue at this moment, but House Hartwood is popular on alternate weeks. I am intending to have a meeting at the Rowany Festival.

SUBMISSIONS

Aelfwine of Peterborough; Saint Bartholomew > new name and device

Or, a tyger passant queue forche maintaining a sword Sable between three cross crosslets fitchy Azure.

Aelfwine is Anglo-Saxon and Peterborough is a town in England. This is the first alternate as the first without the double tail is in conflict with William the Silent who has Or, a natural panther passant guardant Sable (Jan 73). There is a major difference for the crosses and only a minor for adding the sword, I considered the change from panther guardant to tyger not to add sufficient to make these devices clear. The addition of the second tail does make a significant change to the outline.

Saraid na Sterrin; Stormhold > new name and device

Purpure goutty d'eau, a chief invected Argent

The name is Irish and translates as Saraid of the storm. Saraid is from O'Corrain and Maguire, Gaelic Personal Names and 'na Sterrin' is from personal communications with a Gaelic scholar, which is not supplied in writing. The device is clear from conflict.

William Eleison; Stormhold > new name and device

Or, two chevrons cotised and in base an armoured arm embowed fesswise Sable
If William needs documenting then I am in the wrong business. Eleison is a Greek word, which is a name of part of the Mass. The device is clear from conflict.

Elenor of the Grieving Heart. Name only.

Elizabeth Saint Clair. Name only.

The name was submitted as Elizabeth St. Clair. The letter of intent stated "a check of all our name references showed names in both forms, with a larger number shown a St. X than as Saint X." However, no documentary support of this was provided. It should be remembered that, while modern sources generally use the abbreviated form of the name, period manuscripts considered contracted forms precisely that. We would not register "Bndicts" for the Latin name "Benedictus" or "Thos" for "Thomas" yet they are common abbreviations used in many period manuscripts. Laurel's experience during many years of work with original historical and literary documents is confirmed by such secondary sources as Reaney which indicate that scribes regarded the fuller form as the norm, with abbreviations used where required (the citation in Reaney for Sinclair is relevant in this regard: not a single citation shows a form in "St." or its equivalent). Note that the fact that the name is **registered** in its proper form does not forbid the use of abbreviations by scribes where this is appropriate, both in names and in other contexts, and in fact the use of period style ligatures and abbreviations should be encouraged in everyday use.

Llewen the Unruly. Device. Per pale counter-ermine and Or, ermined vert, two trees blasted and eradicated counterchanged argent and sable.

This would have been much more cohesive (and hence better period style) if the sinister portion of the field had been erminois **or** the tree to sinister had been vert.

Marguerite de Rada y Silva. Change of name from Marguerite de Rada.

The name was submitted as Marguerite de Rada y Sylva. It would appear that the lady's intent was to be Marguerite of the Road and Wood and the name does not do this. However, in view of the additional evidence for the use of "Silva" as a family name which she has provided we felt bound to register the name. However, the alternation of "y" and "i" is not random in Spanish and occurs in very rigid circumstances (usually in proper nouns derived from other languages and or/loan words such as "Ysabeau"). We could find no instance of its being substituted in period for a vowel of this sort between two consonants so we have modified the spelling of the name, as her paperwork now allows.

Steven Longshanks. Holding name and device. Per bend wavy gules and argent, a comet bendwise sinister, head to chief, argent and on a heart gules, a rose argent.

The name was submitted as Styvren Longshanks. His mundane given name is Steven. Please instruct him to draw the comet properly with an estoile as the head and the customary wavy rays trailing.

Rhyllan of Starfire Retreat. Change of name from Rhiannon of Starfire Retreat.

As Vesper himself comments, the submitter's arguments that the name is a dithematic Welsh name formed from a protheme "Rhy" and a deutertheme "llian" do not hold linguistic water. Not only does Welsh not form random dithematic combinations, but the alleged name elements do not actually exist as such in Welsh. Since this is the case, it is impossible to consider this "a made-up name consistent with the structure, sound and spelling of existing medieval Welsh names".

Styvren Longshanks. Name only.

The given name was stated to be a manufactured "country variant" of his given name Steven. Unfortunately, even the fertile pen of Yonge (p. 93) was unable to find any form of Stephen that uses a "y" in the first syllable **or** adds an "r" to the final syllable. This is not a reasonable variant.

Brodhir MacDathi

New, name and device.

Azure, in cross four daggers, hilts to center, within a bordure wavy Or.

Documentation from Dunkling's Scottish Christian Names, p.28 at

Broderick, indicates that the given name is Norse, meaning "brother". Bassi does not include it, but gives *Broddr/Broddi*, which may be the same name. *Dathi* is found on p.14 of Woulfe's Irish Names for Children as an old Irish given name, so combining it with the *Mac*-patronymic form is logical. We do not know what the genitive form used in this construction would be, but the submitter will accept corrections.

Eoin O'Halloran

New, name only, see Returns for device.

The given name was submitted as *E'oin*, but we could not justify the form with the apostrophe, so it was changed to the standard form.

The given name is cited on p.88 of O'Corrain & Maguire; the surname is found on p.105 of McLysaght's Guide.

Eric of Stormwind

Name submitted December XXII, new device.

Per chevron azure and argent, two unicorn's heads couped respectant, horns crossed, argent, and a sword azure hilted sable, all within a bordure embattled Or.

Maeva Torfadottir

New, name only.

The given name is cited on p.13 of Bassi. It is probably a borrowing from the Celtic *Meave/Meadhbh*. *Torfi* is cited on p.15 of Bassi, and the patronymic is correctly formed.

Riverhaven, Barony of

Name registered, heraldic title
resubmission to Kingdom.

The Barony wishes to register *Hippocampus Pursuivant* as the title for the Baronial herald. It is a reference to the sea-horse erect in the Baronial arms. This might be considered as a translation of *Seahorse Pursuivant*, which is registered to the East Kingdom. However, *Hippocampus* is NOT actually a translation into Latin of "seahorse"; it is rather the species name for the natural seahorse. (Their first submission, of *Golden Seahorse Pursuivant*, was returned in November XXII as being too similar to the East Kingdom title.) We ask the opinion of the members of the College on this matter, but feel that the title should be registered as it stands. Certainly there is no chance of their being confused.

Thrainn Járngrímsen

New, name and device.

Per bend sinister wavy argent and sable, a unicorn rampant counterchanged and on a chief sable, three roses argent.

Thrainn is found on p.17 of Bassi, and *Járngrímr* on p.12; the patronymic is correctly formed.

This was submitted by the client as "Per bend sinister wavy", but we did not consider the wavy line as adding any difference from a simple per bend sinister line, since the modification of the line largely disappears in the complexity of the counterchange. The use of a complex line of division to counterchange a complex charge is poor style, and should be discouraged.

The following submissions were held for further consultation:

Annabell of Riverhaven

Name submitted December XXII, new device
returned.

Or, a four-headed dragon passant vert maintaining a goblet sable within an orle of torteaux.

The device is too similar to that registered to Aubrey Lowell: "Or, an eagle displayed and dismembered, wings inverted, vert within an orle of gouttes de sang". There is a point for the type of primary charge, but only a minor difference between the type of charges in orle. It is also close to the device registered to Percival de Courcee: "Or, a unicorn's head couped sable within an orle of hearts gules".

Further, the four-headed dragon is not a very distinguishable charge. In fact, it looks like a two-headed dragon with an odd neck and peculiar wings.

Antoine le Rêveur

"Argent, a base of flames sable." Name submitted November XXII, device resubmission to Kingdom returned.

His earlier submission, "Sable, flames of fire from base proper", was returned in November XXII for conflict.

This submission is too similar to the device registered to Bryan de Albengi: "Argent, a demi-eagle rising to sinister, wings elevated and addorsed, purple, issuant from a base rayonny sable".

His alternate, adding a compass star gules in canton, is too similar to the device registered to Julie of the Blackwater: "Per fess rayonny argent and sable, in chief a heart gules".

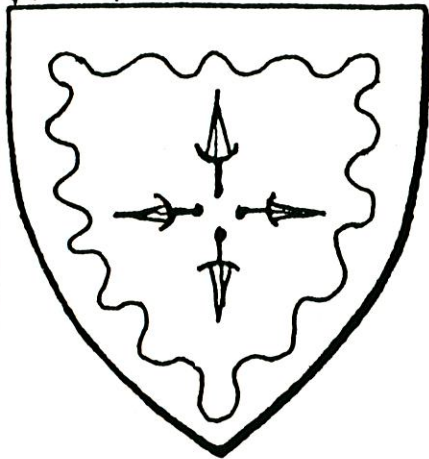
Eoin O'Halloran

Name submitted, new device returned.

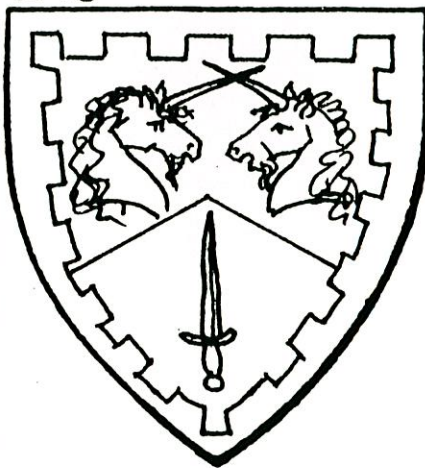
Or, a sea-otter naiant bendwise sinister, legs close, sable.

The creature in this device was drawn in a very modern streamlined fashion, diving with the legs retracted against the body. It was almost impossible to distinguish what the charge was meant to be. Most of the people at the meeting thought it looked like a quill, so that was one of the places we checked for possible conflicts. The device is in visual conflict with the device registered to Melissa Kendal of Westmoreland: "Or, a quill pen bendwise sinister sable, ribbed gules, in canton a Kendal flower proper".
