This submittors device was initially submitted in December 1994 as Argent a dragon passant gules in chief two viking bird pennants respectant and linked in chief argent and sable. This was returned for the fact the pennants where not recognised charges by the S.C.A. college of heralds, rather as art work of the period. The name submitted at this time was Rhuddlan ap Gwilym ap Llwelyn o'r Abermaesteg. This was then returned by Vesper as Rhuddlan is a place name not a first name. It was then submitted as Emlyn ap Gwilym ap Llywelyn o'r Abermaesteg, along with the device Sable, on a bend sinister argent, three dragons passant palewise gules. which was returned by Crux for conflict with the arms of Dive, Sable on a bend sinister argent, three ravens regaurdant sable and an alternate had similar problems. This name was then returned for the presence of the "o'r" (see below) and the fact that the "no changes box" had been ticked. The device of Counter-Ermine on a bend sinister argent three dragons passant palewise gules. submitted with this was then held at Vesper level. He submitted Ralph Emlyn Morgan, his legal name and his English Arms as his device. These were returned, because you cannot submit more than one element of your mundane name, and the device was not compatible with S.C.A. heraldry.

I think the name is finally acceptable. With, Llanfyllin meaning St Myllin's Church, Recorded as Llanvelig in 1254 [6] p 218 and also appears on p25 of [3]. Both Gwalachmai and Llywelyn appear in CA# 66 a Welsh Miscellany and p191 and p201 [1]. This name was submitted as Gwalchmai ap Llywelyn o'r Llanfyllin but the o'r was dropped because it was incorrect, meaning "of the" rather than "of" which is "o'" in Welsh but with actual places the article is removed anyway.

As an aside, the submittor spoke to an Arabic speaker who stated that it seemed like a good name and even went as far as showing him how to write it in Arabic script. (Crux is glad he didn't try to submit it like this I think even LATEX would have baulked or maybe just me trying to type it!).

If you think the return for "o'y" and "o'r" was petty this is the sort of thing that happens if you tick the make no changes box! There is a box that says make grammatical changes to make it correct in the indicated language which, would have made this return unnecessary.

The name is good. Tangwystl and Iestyn are on p213 and p198 respectively of [1] and also appear in the Welsh Miscellany CA# 66. Gogh seems to be the correct form of the word for red, when applied to a female. This might be a problem as in this case the name means Tangwystl daughter of Iestyn the Red. If this is so it might end up as Tangwystl ferch Iestyn Coch. As she will accept minor changes this should not cause grief.

Wystan is from the Old English Wigstan and is dated to 1190 p294 [7] Wallsend was submitted as Walls End but was changed to Wallsend because the place Wallsend, (funnily enough near the end of Hadrians Wall) seems to have always been spelt that way. See [4] p43 Wallesende c1085. Before anyone quotes the example of "Land's End" to me, this place name comes from The Land's End ibid p286 "le Londis end". So if this name was "of the Wall's End" then I would have no hesitation using the two words. However "of Wallsend" is much more consistant.

In the Laurel Letter dated Febuary 1 1996 Pelican examined the question of SCA compatible names and deemed them to be a weirdness. Rhiannon is one such name, not being used as far as we know by humans in period but being too popular to ban outright. As the surname is English, not a period spelling (Durand dated 1115 but Durrand not found until after period), and the fact that the locative has been latinised, this name has to be classed as too "weird". ie having more than two "wierdnesses". A much better name would be Rhiannon Cumberland, although it might still be a little too much and it might be better to try Rhiannon Cumbria as a possible latinization of the whole thing. The name would become much easier if the Rhiannon was dropped.

The device is unfortunately in conflict with *Purpure a donnelly knot or*. Liosliath of Donnelly (SCA April 75).

Language: Old English and Old Norse

This name is documented by the submittor from the Readers Digest Great Encyclopaedic Dictionary 1965, names and native word section. This book after comparison with the trusted sources available to us seems on a par to a baby name book, and should be treated with distrust.

This name has caused us considerable trouble in chasing. Wulfric (pronouced Wulfrich) is common in Searle's Ononmasicon Anglosaxonicum. However there is no evidence of names ending with a "ch". Possibly because this was what was meant by an ending "c". Hrafn is indeed Old Norse for Raven, but the "der" has no place in this name as it is German. The correct epitaph should be just "Hrafn" or possibly "inn Hrafn" but inn seems only to be used before adjectives in my scan of [5] in Old Norse. Better still the name could be put all into Old English with "Hræfen" [2]. As it stands we have a mixture of langauges in the nickname. This is unacceptable and the no changes box has been ticked. If the submittor truely

desires the "der", perhaps the name Wolfrich (a combination Porfinn cooked up from "Wolf..." names and the ending "ric" 1.) would be appropriate.

The sword and rapier rule, which is a precedent that states you can't have two different forms of what are essentially the same thing, in this case two sea-monsters, and XI.3 which states that "Armory that appears to marshal independant arms is considered presumptous". In this case we have two sets of arms marshalled classically in pale.


