Greetings

The college of Heraldry met at the Rowany Festival with most of the business discussed on the 6th., and a consulting table set up for most of the festival. These minutes are being typed a day late as I fell asleep on my return from Rowany.

Present for the meeting were Thorfinn Hrolfsson, Crux Australis Herald; Hrolf Herjolfsson, Pursuivant at large; Rowan Perigryne, Pursuivant at large; Dikran Aivazian; Kyrii Windstrider, acting PE for River Haven; Ulfstan Garmon, acting PE for Mordenvale; Roddhu Oakburn, Cinquefoil Pursuivant Extraordinary; and Dafydd ap Donal ap Gwylim, PE for Politikopolis.

These names, devices and badges were considered by the meeting:-  
Jocelyn Holyer: name registered, a resubmission of device returned at Kingdom, this is a redesign. Or, a sprig of holly proper, within a Jocelin wreathed Argent and Gules. This device seems clear and will be sent to Kingdom.

Lleu ap Macsen: a new submission for name and device. Purpure, a saltire between four lozenges Or. This is in conflict with Katya Wanderer (SCA) Purpure, a saltire between in pale two mullets of four points and in fess an increscent and a decrescent Or. His suggested changes of a saltire wavy and changeing the lozenges to mullets do not clear this conflict. The name shall be sent to kingdom.

Marit the Wanderer: a resubmission for name and device the previous having been eaten by the Pacific Mail Dragon. Per saltire Argent and Azure, a heart Gules charged with a chevron Argent. This is in conflict with Morguesa MacKenna (SCA) Argent, a heart Gules, pierced by a sword inverted proper entwined by a garden rose gules slipped and leaved Vert, Also Stoneley (Papworth944) Azure, a heart Gules pierced by a sword in bend proper and Hall (Papworth945) Argent, a heart Gules depressed by a chevron Gules. The name shall be sent to kingdom.

Sven the Stormdriven: name under consideration by Laurel this is a new submission for a badge. Sable, a quill bendwise sinister within a bordure invected Argent. There is a mon (p92 no. 11) Sable, a feather within a bordure Argent, there is a difference in the line of division. The badge will be sent to kingdom.

Canton of Agaricus: a new submission for name, device and badge. Sable, a laurel wreath Or within five mushrooms two, two and one Argent for the device and Sable, in fess two mushrooms proper (Agaricus Aminita). Both are clear of conflicts and will be sent to kingdom.

Torald o' Hawkhurst: name registered, a resubmission of device and badge returned at kingdom. Device: Sable, a ram's head caboshed and a base chape-ploye argent, within a bordure Gules. This is clear of conflicts. Badge: Argent, a hawk displayed Gules and <sup>on</sup> a base dancetty Sable a hurst of pine trees Argent. This is clear of conflicts. Both shall be sent to kingdom.

Bryony of the Bees


Resubmission to Kingdom, name and device.

Per fess embattled argent and vert, three bees volant counterchanged.

Her previous submission was returned with a request for documentation on the name in September XIX. Her prior device submission of "Vert, a fess argent between in chief three bees volant proper and in base a beehive Or" was returned because the bees were primarily color-on-color.

The given name is taken from the name of the plant. However, it is similar in spelling and pronunciation to the following names which have been registered in the SCA: Brianna (1983), Brianna (1983), Briany (1982), Briony (1980, 1981), Bryanna (1984). We feel that, if the name is not acceptable as a plant name, it should be acceptable as a feminine variant of "Brian", and as a spelling variation of the names which have already passed. If it is ruled that *Bryony* is unacceptable, she is willing to accept Brianna.

We have blazoned the bees as "volant", as it is our recollection that this is SCA usage for bees in this position. What Parker calls "volant", we blazon as "tergiant displayed".



Currently I am waiting a week from when these minutes should arrive at each group and when I am posting the submissions to Kingdom. Are there any objections to me posting the submissions to Kingdom immediately instead.
