The required documents for each submission are as follows:-  
Name and device 3 information sheets and 4 emblazon sheets  
Device or badge only 3 information sheets and 4 emblazon sheets  
Name only 3 information sheets

These are required for original submission and resubmissions. The submitter should also make two other sets of of information sheets and emblazon sheets with one set for themselves and one for their branch herald.

Argent, two unicorns salient addorsed regardant horns crossed in saltire Sable, surrmounted by a maltese cross Gules. This is in conflict with Argent, a maltese cross Gules; the Order of S Stefano, Pisa from Papworth.
